The committee will offer free tent space during the second weekend of the festival to any students. The Student Crafter area is a pre-designated area at The Fort Bedford Park. The craft must be made and sold entirely by the students. Parental supervision will be expected with younger participants. All participants must provide and are responsible for their own equipment. The committee will provide a tent; the crafter must provide their display table. A complete set of rules and schedule will be sent after the close of registration on September 15, 2024. You must sign up to participate. Due to new food service regulations, no food products prepared in your home kitchens can be sold. Space is limited and your day choice cannot be guaranteed.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- All crafts in booths, must be handmade by the student crafter. No kits or manufactured items permitted.
- The craft must be made and sold entirely by the students.
- Student crafters must be school aged (K-12) Parental supervision will be expected with younger participants.
- The crafter book must be open and staffed during all show hours.
